Directions: Choose a Baroque, Classical or Romantic Era Composer to research. You may either do a written report, a poster or a power point presentation that you will present to the class.

Your goal is to answer the following questions about your composer:

- Birth and Death
 - o Where?
 - o When?
 - o Cause of death?
- Childhood and Adolescence
 - o Did anything interesting happen to him/her during childhood or adolescence?
 - o Who were his/her parents? What was their occupation?
 - o What kind of home did he/she live in?
- Personal Life
 - o Did he/she marry? Who? Where did they live? How long were they married?
 - o Did he/she have any hobbies or pastimes?
 - o Do you know what religion he/she was affiliated with?
- Professional Life
 - o Which era was he/she considered to be a part of?
 - o What are several of his/her most famous works?
 - o What made them so famous? A composition? Performance? New type of arrangement? Improving an instrument?
- Extra Credit
 - o Play a recording of his/her works to receive 1 point extra credit.
 - o Play or sing on of his/her works to receive 5 points extra credit.

Poster

You should choose this option if:

- you are creative, neat and organized
- you have access to craft materials.
- you enjoy cutting and pasting, coloring, decorating, etc.

Your poster should.

- be on a large poster board.
- answer the questions above in neat handwriting or carefully cutup printed facts
- be filled with creatively displayed pictures of the composer and things that are relevant to his/her life
- be with you on the day it's due.

Report

You should choose this option if:

- you like to tell stories.
- you like to write and organize information in words.
- are able to express your findings well in paragraph form.

Your report should:

- be typed, using a 12 point, easy to read font in black ink
- be at least two pages in length.
- answer the questions above in an organized and sequential order.
- have a creative title.
- be printed out and brought to class on the day it's due

Power Point

You should choose this option if:

- you can organize facts well in bullet form:
- you like to work with computers (clip art, slide design, animation effects etc.)

Your power point should:

- be at least eight slides with solid information on them.
- answer the questions above using bullets.
- incorporate pictures to enhance your facts.
- be saved to your folder in your school file by the day it's due. (saving to your flash drive is not enough!)

Use at least 3 sources. Only 1 of those sources may be the Internet

NOTE: Everyone must have a different composer!
